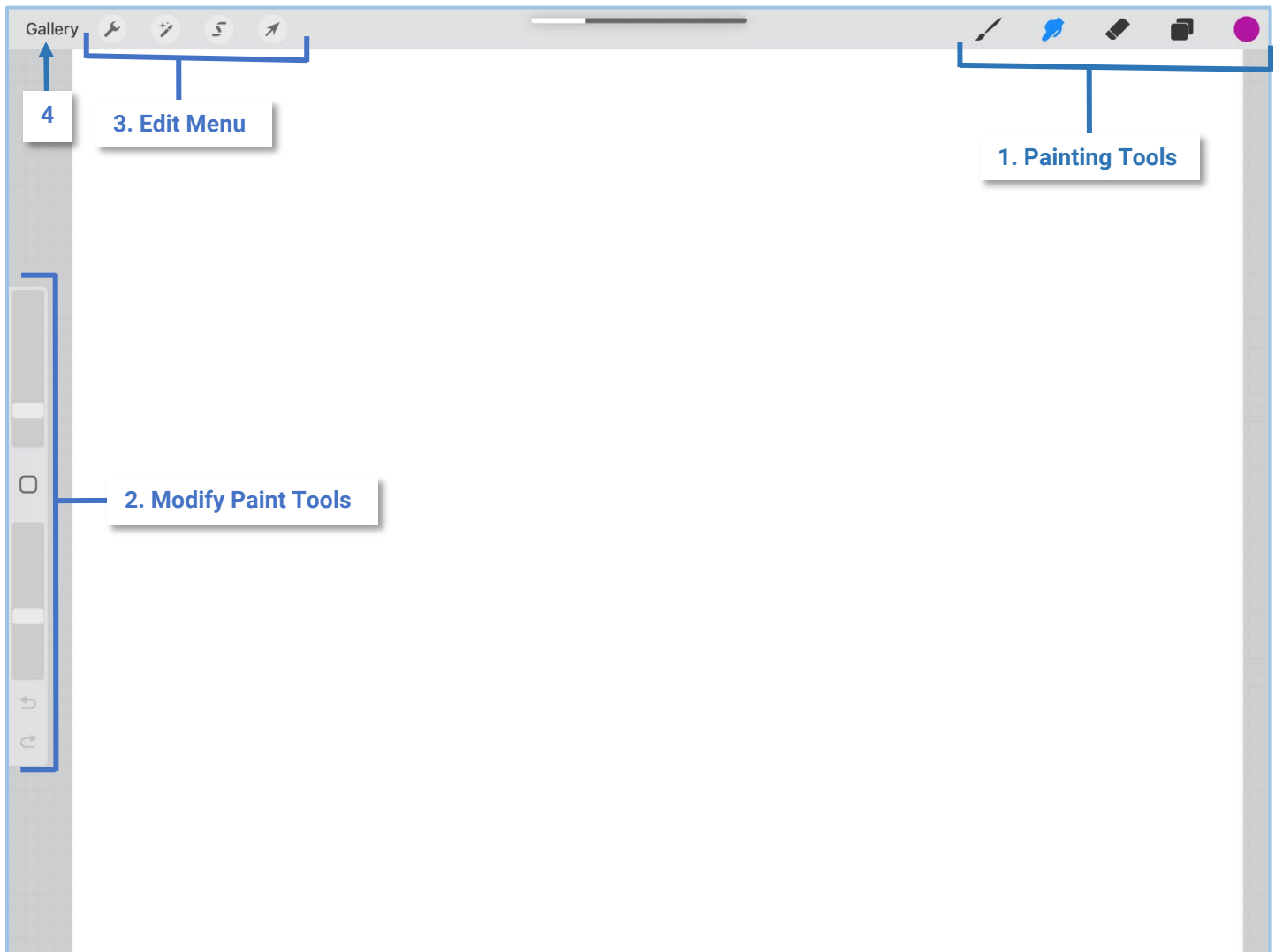


Procreate | Helpful Guide 2024

THE INTERFACE:



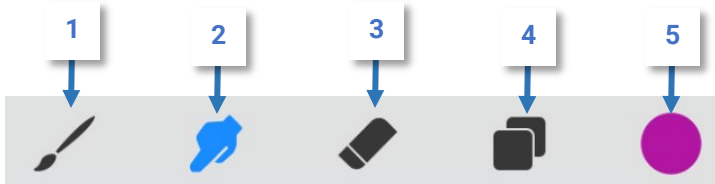
1. Painting Tools: Paint, smudge, erase, create layers of artwork, and choose colors.

2. Modify Paint Tools: This allows you to pick colors straight from your artwork. Slide the eyedropper over a color you want to pick and release your finger to select it.

3. Edit Menu: All the features you need to make complex adjustments to your art.

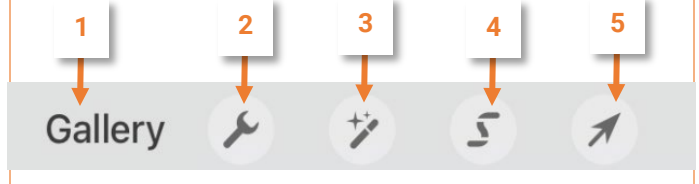
4. Gallery: Press this to return to the gallery. The gallery is where you organize and manage your artworks. You can create new canvases, import images, and share your creations with the world.

PAINTING TOOLS

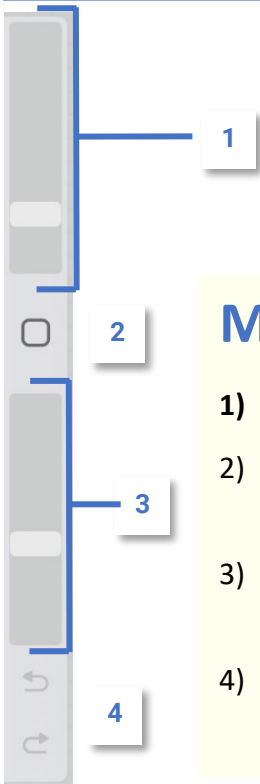


- 1) **Brushes:** Draw and paint with hundreds of smooth and versatile brushes. Organize your Brush Library, import custom brushes, or share your own unique brush creations.
- 2) **History:** a history of your actions, which you can preview and edit.
- 3) **Libraries:** A place to store your favorite elements in the Cloud, so you can reuse them in other documents.
- 4) **Properties:** Provides options unique to each tool. Similar to the Control Panel.
- 5) **Options Bar:** Provides options specific to each tool.

EDIT MENU



- 1) **Gallery:** Press this to close your document and return to the Gallery where all your files are kept and you can create new documents.
- 2) **Actions:** Here is where you can share, adjust your canvas and any of the elements within it. You can also adjust interface and touch settings to get more out of your workflow.
- 3) **Adjustments:** Add important finishing touches with image effects in the Adjustments menu. Make complex color adjustments fast. Adjust your image with Blur, Sharpen, Noise, Clone, and Liquify.
- 4) **Selections:** Selections allow you to isolate any part of your image with four different selection methods.
- 5) **Transform:** Transform allows you to stretch, move, and manipulate your image. Scale, rotate, skew, reflect, and warp.



MODIFY BAR

- 1) **Size:** Slide up and down to adjust the size of your brush.
- 2) **Eyedropper Tool:** This allows you to pick colors straight from your artwork. Slide the eyedropper over a color you want to pick and release your finger to select it.
- 3) **Opacity:** Increase or decrease your brush opacity from transparent to solid, by dragging the bottom slider up or down.
- 4) **Undo/Redo:** Undo or Redo any action. Great for correcting mistakes!
