Owl

The owl is a guide of wisdom and intuition, able to see clearly through the dark and uncover what's hidden. Choosing an owl feather invites you to trust your inner knowing and look beyond appearances.



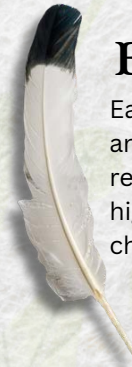
Raven

Eagles embody strength, courage, and freedom. Their feathers remind you to connect with your higher self and approach challenges with confidence.



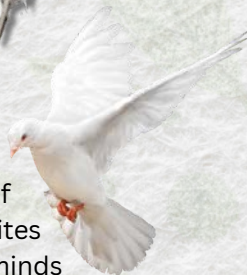
Hawk

Heron

Cardinal
