BEGIN CLASS

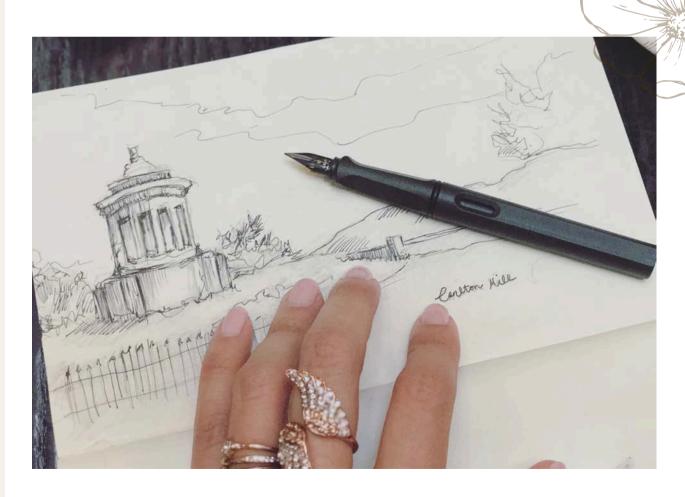
WEEKLY CHECKLIST

- **WEEK 3:** Watch the next lesson. Focus on drawing scenes or vignettes from your day. Try combining words with your sketches.
- **WEEK 4:** Finish the final video. Review your sketchbook pages and add finishing touches. Choose 1-2 pieces to share with the group or reflect on.

BONUS SKETCHBOOK PROMPTS

- Sketch your coffee or tea setup in the morning.
- Draw the view outside your window.
- Sketch something you always carry with you.
- Capture a corner of a favorite room in your home.

• Visit a local park or outdoor space and sketch what you see.
